- · Larger installations can be controlled by a single thermostat and 15 amp relays or divided into multiple zones with additional thermostats.
- Standard cold lead lengths are 6', 10' and 20'. Other lengths may be available.
- Submit drawings in .dwg or .dxf format if possible. .pdf is also acceptable.
- Show heated floor area. A simple border is sufficient, and cold lead location and length on dedicated layer if possible. Typical pull back is 2" from all walls.
- · Include layout of unmovable items such as a toilet, walls, cabinets, and furniture and penetrations such as drains or other holes/obstructions.
- · Gold Heat mats must be installed on a dedicated circuit for radiant heat (without outlets) in accordance with the National Electric Code.
- There is no maximum amount of mats or zones on a circuit.
- Gold Heat supplied floor sensing thermostats include an integral 5mA GFCI.
- A Gold Heat mat must be protected by a GFCI per National Electrical Code. If a GFCI thermostat is not used, Gold Heat recommends installing on a dedicated circuit with a GFCI circuit breaker.
